### How do I get started?

#### 1. Pre-register

#### 4. Be a team leader.

#### 5. Ask your employer to match your funds.

Check to see if your employer has a matching gift program, or will provide incentives for employees walking on your team.

#### 6. Donate a Memory Marker.

With a \$100 donation received before April 1, you may put your loved one's name on a Memory Marker placed along the route.
